





Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Ambrose Parish Family,

In the Gospel for this Fifth Sunday of Lent, we are told that some Greeks approached the apostle Philip and said, "Sir, we would like to see Jesus." We are very blessed at St. Ambrose that so many have been making the same request to us. Many of these people have decided to follow Jesus and will be baptized at the Easter Vigil. and when he was made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him. (Heb 5:8-9)


Gospel:






