



Or: Alleluia.


Second Reading:

For the past few years, after the death of longtime organist Tony Jacobs, St. Ambrose has been searching for a Director of Music and Liturgy. I am so grateful to John Meehan, Cass Kiefer and Margaret Erthal for their dedication to the music ministry during this search. I am hopeful they will continue sharing their gifts with our parish well into the future. I am grateful to Joan Sonderen and Kim Wackerly who directed the adult choir when John Meehan began playing the organ after Tony's death. Most recently, John Meehan has been doing double duty (playing and directing). I would also like to mention that John "retired" from his position prior to Tony's death and graciously agreed to come out of retirement to serve the parish.

With gratitude to God, I am happy to announce that we have hired a Director of Music and Liturgy whose service to St. Ambrose will begin on July 1, 2024.



Stephen Stack has been the Pastoral Associate for Liturgy and Music at St. Jerome Church in Troy, Illinois from 1997-2000, and 2003-2024. From November 2000 to July 2002, he had a similar position at Immaculate Conception Church, Columbia, IL; he then pursued a possible vocation as a monk of St. Meinrad Archabbey, where he served as organist for the community, before returning to St. Jerome in February 2003.

He has a B.A. in Philosophy from Cardinal Glennon College (Seminary) in St. Louis (1985), and a Master of Divinity (M.Div.) from the University of St. Mary of the Lake - Mundelein Seminary, Chicago (1995). While he completed studies for priesthood, he felt called to serve the Church as a layman in liturgy and music ministry. He is a composer and arranger; he has served as cantor, instrumentalist (piano, organ, bass guitar), and choir and ensemble director since age 13. Other musical pursuits include singing in the Heartland Community Chorus (Highland, IL), and playing keyboards and singing with the Irish Aires—a St. Louis area Irish folk band.

I am most grateful that Steve Stack has accepted this position at St. Ambrose and look forward to his ministry among us.




William "Bill" C. Horn, 88, died Friday, March 22, 2024 at DePaul
